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CONTINUATION OF THE FINDING LIST

This listing gives the physical and physical descriptions of all the papers of Felix Kaufmann, except for his bound newspaper. The material has been numbered, listed, and microfilmed in the order in which it was found, and in the letterpress order.

The finding list consists of two parts. The first part lists the original documents in the order in which they were found. The second part lists the same documents in alphabetical order under the names of the persons or subjects mentioned in the original documents. The finding list is divided into three sections: (1) the finding list of the original documents; (2) the finding list of the microfilm copies; and (3) the finding list of the microfilm copies of the original documents.

The table of contents of this list provides the page number of each folder of the Kaufmann files, the page number at which the folder is listed, and the page number of the first page of any article which is to be referred to in the finding list. The table of contents is arranged in alphabetical order of contents by the headings of the alphabet, except that

all information in the finding list which appears in square brackets is my interpretation. The names given for the papers are approximate.

## DESCRIPTION OF THE FINDING LIST

This listing gives the placing and physical description of all the papers of Felix Kaufmann, except for his bound notebooks. The Nachlass has been numbered, listed, and microfilmed in the order in which it was found. Many of the letters, essays, notes, and critical commentaries were found arranged into folders according to topic. In some cases I have provided titles for the folders. The letters, etc. which were already taken out of the general correspondence and arranged by subject matter are to be found in Section I of the finding list (volume I). Section II (volume II, A-K; volume III, L-Z) contains the balance of the correspondence arranged by name. Section III lists the off-prints, journal articles, clippings, etc. which were not arranged by topic. These were not microfilmed, but were listed in the order found.

The table of contents of this list provides two page numbers for each folder of the Nachlass; the page number at which the folder is listed, and the page number of the first page of the Nachlass which is in that folder. The correspondence in Section II has been listed in the table of contents by the letters of the alphabet, rather than by name.

All information in the finding list which appears in square brackets is my interpolation. The sizes given for the pages are approximate.
